FOREWORD

Following my retirement in 1972, I became interested in family history. My brother Mac had assisted in the preparation of Grabowski's "The DuVal Family of Virginia", and at his death his records were available to me through his twin brother, Jack.

Through my research at the Swem Library at William & Mary College, Williamsburg, I chanced on a letter sent by Mrs. Grabowski to the W. & M. Quarterly. The letter has no date, but was printed in the Quarterly, 2nd Series, Volume 12, p.203, July 1932. Mrs. Grabowski died in 1933, while preparing a supplement to her book.

I considered my find to be important to the family history, and decided to try to locate the DuVal family bible. In the clerk's office in Lynchburg, Va. I found the last will and testament of John D. Easley, leaving his estate to his wife. I located her will, leaving her estate to Florence Bouldin and Mrs. Paul C. Edwards, sisters in Halifax, Va. Efforts to locate the DuVal family bible through them proved fruitless. I then contacted Mr. Owen R. Easley, Jr. of Chesapeake, Va. and found that he knew nothing of the whereabouts of the DuVal bible. I still hope that the bible can be found.

DuVal.—I am sending herewith a record of the DuVal family, of which I wrote in my book, but which came to me too late to use in that book.

It is the first record we have found which gives the exact name of the first Daniel DuVal's wife, who he married after arriving in Virginia, though she too came from France, the record is found in an old Bible belonging to Mr. John D. Easley, Atty., of Lynchburg, Va. I understand it came to him through his Mother and Grand mother, the first, being Minnie Horsley, who married William Easley, and her mother being Eliza Perkins who married a Horsley.

They are direct descendants of Philadelphia DuVal who married Major Andrew Dunscomb, and their daughter Philadelphia Hamilton Dunscomb who married Mr. John Horsley.

The record states:

"Philadelphia DuVal was the daughter of Col. Samuel DuVal and Lucie Claiborne, of King William Co. and Col. Samuel DuVal who married Lucie Claiborne, was the son of the Chevalier Daniel DuVal, French Huguenot, and his wife, Philadelphia DuBois of France."

It is interesting to notice that Philadelphia DuVal, who married Major Andrew Dunscomb, named her two daughters for this grand mother, i. e.:

Philadelphia H. Dunscomb, who married John Horsley and, Lucy Woods Dunscomb who married Mr. Asbury Christian.

The DuBois family had their name anglicised to Wood or Woods, when they came to America, hence the middle name of the daughter above.

The Dubois and the DuVal families are supposed to have been very good friends in France, and that one of these families brought with them to America, a gold tureen, which had belonged to the Abbe DuBois in France. It is described fully by several who have seen it.

A small gold tureen, set in a red leather box or case lined with red velvet. It had on it the intertwined emblems of the two families, a tuft of Lilies, surrounded by Thorns, and the motto, "Lilia inter pinos."

Tradition says that it came to Major William DuVal of Richmond, from his father or Mother who was this Philadelphia DuBois, and passed then into the hands of his daughter, Mrs. Price, and to one of their sons, who married a lady from the North. On his death, she not caring for his family, sold the tureen and other plate privately, and never let the DuVal family know where it had gone. In this way it passed out of the family entirely.—Bessie Berry Grabowskii, 1421 Hanover Avenue, Richmond, Virginia.

Bettie Dabney Duval was born on 15 January, 1885 in Culpeper County, Virginia. She had a congenital deformity known as Spina Bifida. She died on 31 January, 1959, and was buried on private property of Edgar O. Willis in Lignum, Virginia.

He died with his last illness in 1959, with the exception of the period he spent in military service during World War I.

He volunteered for service and was Captain of Company A, 10th Infantry, 80th Division, leading his Company in the Meuse-Ardenne offensive. He was seriously wounded by shrapnel, but eventually recovered fully, so that at the end of the conflict, he returned to the practice of law. He was a member of the Richmond and the Virginia Bar Associations, and served as substitute Judge of the Civil Justice Court of the City of Richmond. As Counsel for the Medical Society of Virginia, he drafted the Medical Practice Act of Virginia, setting up the Medical Examiners System. John Billingsley Duval, a twin of Robert Cammack Duval, Jr., was born 11/13/86 in Fauquier Co Va. He attended a one room school in Orange County, before entering Fork Union Military Academy from which he was graduated. Jack entered Richmond College of the University of Richmond, receiving a B.A. degree in 1911 and an LLB degree in 1913. Always an honor student, he was elected to Phi Beta Kappa and joined the Pi Kappa Alpha social fraternity. With the exception of military service in World War I, he practiced law in Richmond with his twin brother until the brother's death in 1959. After that, he continued a partnership with William Read Miller III, who as Mack's son-in-law, had joined the firm several years earlier.

Jack volunteered for military service in World War I, but was deferred by reason of a hernia. After surgery, he was then accepted as a Lieutenant of Artillery, but never served overseas. After returning to law practice with his brother, he became Secretary of the Richmond Bar Association, serving from 1919-1957. In 1957, he was elected Vice President and in 1958, President of the Richmond Bar. During his Presidency, the Junior Bar Section of the Association was formed.

Always an excellent golfer, he was President of the Country Club of Virginia from 1947-49. He was for many years a member of the Richmond German Club.

In 1953, he married Margaret Ward Anderson of Richmond. He never fully retired from law practice, maintaining a small office in the Tuakahoe Apartment where he and Peggy lived until his death at the ripe old age of 93 on January 11, 1980. Graveside funeral services were held in Hollywood Cemetery in Richmond.

Maria Christine Duval was born at Ellwood Manor in Spotsylvania County, Va. on January 1, 1889. She attended a one room school through the 7th grade, then attended a private school and the High School at Lignum, Culpeper County, graduating in 1906. Then she attended Rawlings Institute in Charlottesville for one year before teaching in Hanover County for twelve months. Christine then re-entered Rawlings Institute, receiving her BA degree in 1909. She returned to teaching in Lahove, Orange County, and Clintwood High in Dickenson County, and then in Unionville High, Orange County, until 1914.

On June 20, 1914, she married William Streit Dickinson and lived with his parents until 1917 when the couple purchased a farm in Stafford County named Hollywood. In 1919, this farm was sold and another farm named "Wilburn" purchased in Spotsylvania Co. where they lived until 1961. Upon Will's retirement, a new small house was built on a corner lot of the farm, and they lived there for the rest of their natural lives. They had four children, one girl and three boys and seven grandchildren. Burial of both was in the Oak Hill Cemetery, Fredericksburg, Va.

Christine was active in community work at a time when few women were. This work included PTA and Home Demonstration Clubs. She was President of the first Home Demonstration Club in Spotsylvania County, and later served as President of the State Federation of Home Demonstration Clubs, as well as Chairman of the State Public Relations Committee. In 1955, she was awarded the Certificate of Merit by Virginia Polytechnic Institute. Edward Alexander Duval was born at Ellwood Manor in Spotsylvania County, Va. He attended one room schools and was considered the only slow-learner among the Duval children. He attended Lignum High School in Culpeper County for a short time, but failed to adjust, so returned home to help his father at "Hunter's Lodge", the family farm on Mine Run, near Locust Grove, Va.

In 1918, he was drafted into the Army as a Private, and after a short training period at Ft. Lee, near Petersburg, Va., was shipped overseas for combat duty. When the armistice was signed, Ned returned from France and Germany, where he had served with the "Rainbow Division" commanded by General Douglas Mac Arthur in the Army of Occupation. Following his discharge, Ned returned to the farm, where he remained for many years.

Ned never married, but spent the last 30 years of his life as a domiciliary patient at the Veterans Facility in Hampton, Va. where he died on October 6, 1966. Funeral services were held at the grave in the family plot at Rhoadesville Baptist Church, Orange County, Va. where he had been a regular member.

Harry was a leader in the Southern Diocese of the Episcopal Church in Virginia, a founder of St. Michael's in Sun Air, Va. where he served as Senior Warden. Harry was also on the Diocesan Standing Committee and Executive Committee, was Chairman of the Diocesan Forward and Advance Fund for new mission churches, and was a lay delegate to the General Convention.

After retirement, he spent much leisure time in wood-working and in repair and construction of household furniture. He died in Richmond on Sept. 11, 1978. Funeral services were held at the grave in Hollywood Cemetery, Richmond. His widow, Thelma, died May 11, 1978, and is also buried in Hollywood.

HARRY GORDON DUVAL  
"Harry"

Harry Gordon Duval was born at Ellwood Manor, Spotsylvania County, Va. on October 4, 1892. The family moved to "Hunter's Lodge" in 1897, a farm on Mine Run. There, Harry attended a one room school through 7th grade, and then lived with his grandfather, John Dabney Billingsley, in Culpeper County, where he graduated from Lignum High School in 1910.

Harry had a serious accident on the farm when a loaded pistol cartridge exploded in his hand, causing the loss of his thumb, and three fingers of his left hand. Even so, he became a star pitcher on high school and college baseball teams.

In 1914, he graduated from Richmond College of the University of Richmond, where he was a member of Pi Kappa Alpha fraternity. He then taught at Chatham Training School, later known as Hargrave Military Academy, and served as Superintendent of Schools in Clifton Forge, Virginia.

On August 25, 1921, he married Mary Thelma Turner of Richmond, and had one daughter, Nancy Turner, and two grandchildren.

During World War I, he served in the U.S. Army, before beginning work in Richmond as a salesman for B.T. Crump Co. He then opened his own business in radio sales and service, Richmond Radio Shop, with his brother Jimmy. In 1931, he organized the Duval Distributing Company, as wholesaler of radios and television. This business was sold in 1954, and for a short time before retirement, he worked as a manufacturer's representative.

Harry was a leader in the Southern Diocese of the Episcopal Church in Virginia, a founder of St. Michael's in Bon Air, Va. where he served as Senior Warden. Harry was also on the Diocesan Standing Committee and Executive Committee, was Chairman of the Diocesan Forward and Advance Fund for new mission churches, and was a lay delegate to the General Convention.

After retirement, he spent much leisure time in wood-working and in repair and construction of household furniture. He died in Richmond on Sept. 12, 1975. Funeral services were held at the grave in Hollywood Cemetery, Richmond. His widow, Thelma, died May 11, 1978, and is also buried in Hollywood.

CHARLES DABNEY DUVAL  
" Charles"

Charles Dabney Duval was born at Ellwood Manor in Spotsylvania County, Va. on October 9, 1894. Three years later his parents bought a 200 acre farm, "Hunter's Lodge", from the Captain Rowe estate. The farm was located on Mine Run, near Locust Grove, in Orange County, Va.

Charles attended a one room school through the 7th grade, and later attended Mine Run and Unionville High Schools, before graduating from Chatham Training School (Hargrave Military Academy) in 1915. From 1917-18, he attended Richmond College of the University of Richmond, where he joined the Pi Kappa Alpha fraternity. When World War I was declared, Charles left college to work on the farm with his father, instead of entering military service, since five brothers were already on active duty.

In 1919, he moved to Orange Court House to work in the Rawlings Grocery, and then in Page's Drug Store until 1942, when he became a cashier in the National Bank of Orange. He held this position until 1964 when he retired.

In 1938, Charles was married to Virginia Saunders Wood of Orange, a graduate nurse. They built a new home in 1948 at 205 Lee Avenue, where he was continuing to live in 1982. They never had children, and Virginia died in 1970 of a heart attack. Both were active in church and community affairs most of their life. Charles served on the Board of Deacons and for many years as Treasurer of the Orange Baptist Church.

LUCY LIPSCOMB DUVAL

"Lucy"

Lucy Lipscomb Duval was born at Ellwood Manor in Spotsylvania County, Va. on November 21, 1896.

She attended a one room school through the 7th grade, and then moved to Culpeper County to live with her cousin, Edgar Willis, in order to attend the Lignum High School, from which she was graduated. For the next two years, she attended Fredericksburg State Teacher's College, which was later renamed, Mary Washington College, in Fredericksburg. This two-year teaching certificate entitled her to teach in Virginia, but Lucy continued her education through summer vacation periods, and over the years, ultimately graduated from Mary Washington with a B.A. degree.

Most of her many years of teaching were spent in Norfolk, Va. where she taught in Ruffner Junior High School, prior to her retirement and return to Fredericksburg to be near her widowed sister, Christine. Lucy maintained her own residence in later years, until ill health necessitated breaking up housekeeping and moving to Westminster-Canterbury Health Care Center in Richmond, Va. where she spent the last three years of her life.

Lucy died in Richmond Memorial Hospital on June 25, 1982. Funeral services were held at the grave in Rhoadesville Baptist Church Cemetery, Orange County, Va. where her parents and paternal grandmother were also buried. Since her baptism at Rhoadesville Baptist Church as a child, Lucy had kept up her membership in this church while living elsewhere.

ASCHAM JAMES DUVAL  
" Jimmy "

Ascham James Duval was born at "Hunter's Lodge", the Duval farm near Locust Grove in Orange County, Va. on November 20, 1899. He attended a one room elementary school through the 7th grade. Then he went to the Mine Run High School and Chatham Training School, which is now known as Hargrave Military Academy, where he graduated in 1916.

After working on the farm for a year, he enrolled in Richmond College of the University of Richmond, for two years, during which time he joined the Student Army Training Center program for military training in the U.S. Army, until the Armistice was signed in 1918.

In 1919, Jimmy obtained a teaching certificate and taught for one year in Smithfield High School, Sussex County, before becoming Principal of Saluda High in Middlesex County, where he remained until 1929.

That year, he joined his brother Harry, who had established a radio sales business in Richmond, later known as the Richmond Radio Shop. In 1931, he purchased Harry's share of the business and was sole owner until 1938 when the Watkins brothers joined the firm. Upon Jimmy's retirement in 1964, they bought the business.

On November 15, 1930, Jimmy married Emily Louise Palmer in Christ Church, Saluda, where many ancestors of both marriage partners had worshipped. He was subsequently an active communicant of St. Stephen's Episcopal Church, Richmond, Va. which he joined in 1929.

In 1982, Louise and Jimmy lived at 604 Henri Road, Richmond, in the home they built in 1930. Their two sons, James Palmer and Robert Carey provided this marriage with six grandchildren.

He served as First President of both Washington Psychiatric Society and the Medical Society of St. Elizabeth's Hospital. He was quite active in the American Psychiatric Association, serving on Council and as Treasurer and Vice President. He was also qualified by APA as a Mental Health Administrator.

He held Superior Service and Distinguished Service Awards from the U.S. Dept. of Health, Education & Welfare, life membership in Washington Psychiatric Society, membership in South West Medical Honor Society of George Washington University, a Distinguished Service Award from District of Columbia and also from Georgia College at Milledgeville.

ADDISON McGUIRE DUVAL  
"Ad"

Addison McGuire Duval was born at "Hunter's Lodge", Orange Co. Va. on July 1, 1902. He attended a one room school through 7th grade, and, for three years, attended Mine Run and Unionville High Schools. His last year was spent with an uncle in Culpeper Co. where he graduated from Lignum High School in 1918. He enrolled in Richmond College, University of Richmond, for 2 yrs, and then with his sister Christine's guidance, was appointed Principal and teacher in the new High School at Marye in Spotsylvania Co. He remained there for 3 yrs., returning to Richmond College to complete his pre-med courses. In 1925, he entered Medical College of Va. from which he received his M.D. degree in 1929. Ad was golf champion in medical school, manager of the school paper, "Skull & Bones", organized and sang in the school's vocal quartet. He joined Pi Kappa Alpha fraternity at Richmond College, and Phi Chi medical fraternity at the Medical College.

In 1939, he married Mary Elizabeth Weymouth, a graduate nurse from Newport News, by whom he had 2 children, Martha Weymouth in 1931, and Robert Cammack in 1933. Subsequently, there were 7 grandchildren.

His professional experience began with Internship at St. Elizabeth's Hospital, Washington, D.C. and appointment to its permanent staff in 1930, where he was promoted through the ranks to become Assistant Superintendent before retirement in 1959. From 1959-61, he was the Director of the Missouri Division of Mental Diseases, a position he voluntarily relinquished after a political bout with the Governor. He served as Director of Training & Research at Eastern State Hospital in Williamsburg for one year, before leaving to accept a job as Director, Division of Mental Health for the state of Georgia. This proved to be the highlight of his career, especially this opportunity to work closely with Governor Jimmy Carter, who later became the President of the United States.

Over a long career, Addison's personal and professional honors were many. He served as Clinical Professor of Psychiatry at George Washington University, University of Missouri Medical School, and Emory University Medical School in Georgia. He became a Diplomate of the American Board of Psychiatry & Neurology in 1938, and a Fellow of the American Psychiatric Association and American College of Psychiatrists. He served as first President of both Washington Psychiatric Society and the Medical Society of St. Elizabeth's Hospital. He was quite active in the American Psychiatric Association, serving on Council and as Treasurer and Vice President. He was also qualified by APA as a Mental Health Administrator.

He held Superior Service and Distinguished Service Awards from the US. Dept. of Health, Education & Welfare, life membership in Washington Psychiatric Society, membership in Smith Reed Russell Honor Society of George Washington University, a Distinguished Service Award from District of Columbia and also from Georgia College at Milledgeville.

The Professional Library of Georgia Mental Health Institute in Atlanta was named "Addison M. Duval Library", and a rose garden with 10 spokes of a wheel, representing his 10 yrs of service, was planted at Atlanta Regional Hospital and named in his honor. Perhaps the most unique distinction was a proclamation by Governor Carter of July 19, 1972 as "Addison Duval Day" in the state of Georgia.

For many years a lay reader in the Episcopal Church, Addison served at St. Mary's in Missouri, All Saints in Georgia, and Bruton Parish, St. George's and St. Andrew's in Virginia.

His wife, Betty, died of cancer in 1977. In 1978, he married a Newport News widow, Elsie West Meehan, who was then Executive Director of the Voluntary Action Center. Following her retirement in 1979, they became a working team in various kinds of community service, with mutual interests and activities at both local and state levels. In 1982, Elsie and Addison reside at 41 Woodfin Road, Newport News, Va.
